No students upstairs before school

There is no formal teacher supervision inside the school building before 9am, usually because most teachers are either on duty outside, in meetings, at activity practices or preparing for the school day.

Recently, there have been a number of incidents related to students delivering bags to their classrooms and not following safety procedures and school rules. This has been of greatest concern in the upstairs part of the school.

Therefore, no student is to go upstairs before school for any reason, including to deliver their school bags. At 9am, when the music begins, all K-6 students will line up at their designated location and wait for their teacher to lead them into class. For students with expensive Band instruments, if they need to place their instruments in a safe place inside the building, they MUST be escorted by a teacher.

Students in downstairs classrooms can place their bags in their designated bag boxes before school to help avoid traffic issues later but MUST leave the building immediately.
